WELCOME

Welcome to Central West Women's Health Centre, a community-based service run by women for women.

Women of all ages, cultures, sexual orientation, gender identity and beliefs are welcome.

We believe every woman has the right to make her own informed decisions about her health and her life.

Our trained team has a wide range of skills that cater for your health care needs. We aim to improve women's mental and physical well-being by promoting healthy lifestyles and providing access to reproductive health services. We also provide services for women who are experiencing depression or affected by violence.

SERVICES WE OFFER

Generalist Counselling for a range of issues including sexual assault, domestic/family violence, adult survivors of child abuse/sexual assault, depression, anxiety, grief/loss, carers, disability, self-esteem, identity, isolation and trauma.

Women's Health Nurse Clinic services include Cervical Screening (replaces PAP test), Sexual Health Screening, Postnatal checks, Pregnancy testing, Birth control methods, Family planning, Period problems, Menopause changes, Breast health, Continence support. Please Note: The nurse is unable to provide scripts, referrals to specialists or blood tests.

Child, Adolescent Trauma Counselling Service CATS) is available for children and adolescents (under 18) who have been affected by abuse, (physical, emotional, mental, sexual), domestic & family violence, significant neglect, at risk of significant harm, or in 'out of home care'.

The counsellor also works with parents, carers and family members of the children and adolescents. Parenting programs are offered.

Support Service (also known as Case Management) services include support to access appropriate services, advocacy, provision of appropriate information, assistance with forms, safety planning, and other personal skill development.

Free Women's Walking Group held every Monday morning at 9.30am. A wonderful way to meet other women and get fit at the same time.

Health Promotion Sessions and Groups are offered covering a range of women's health issues. Groups include: Midlife Metamorphosis (menopause, mood & more), Mothers & Daughters (puberty matters), Women's Healing Circle (a family violence support program for women), Mindfulness, Healthy Lifestyles. Contact us to discuss other sessions of interest.

Yoga Classes are held throughout the year on. All women welcome. Contact us for registration details.

Provide speakers for women's groups and other service providers.

Our fee structure is put in place to support the centre and to allow us to continue to service our community.

The Women's Health Nurse Clinic is provided free of charge.

We offer concession to those who are eligible or unable to pay full fees.

All children's services are free or invite a small donation.

No woman will be turned away because she cannot afford to pay.
