Terms and Conditions

Terms and Conditions of entry:

- One entry per person, per category.
- Entry into this competition is free and open to Bathurst women and girls* of all ages.
- Entries need to be submitted in .jpg format and suitable to be printed in A4 size.
- Entries are to be sent to
- Entries must be suitable for exhibition within the Centre – Central West Women's Health Centre reserves the right to not include entries deemed unsuitable due to the graphic or offensive nature of the image.
- A new entry form will need to be submitted for each entry and each entry sent in an individual email.
- Each entry needs to include signed permission by the photographer and the subject/s for the work to be displayed (in the Centre, online, and in print) or shared for publicity purposes. If either the photographer or subject/s of the photo are under 18, a parent/guardian will also need to give signed permission.
- Each entry needs to include a declaration signed by the photographer stating that their entry is their own work and that they have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions of entry.
- The first 30 entries received in each category will be included in the public vote and published in the "Celebrating Women and Girls of Bathurst" photo book. After 30 entries are received in each category, it will close.
- The top 3 photos in each category (as voted by the public) will become apart of a permanent display in the Centre.
- Entries open Monday 5th February 2024 and close at 6pm on Sunday 18th February 2024 (individual categories reaching 30 entries will close before this date – entries included on a first received basis).
- Public voting online opens 20th February and closes 27th February.
